

Weather Resilience Information Sheet for Normanton on Soar

Introduction:

This weather resilience information aims to reduce the risk of injury or damage to people and property that may result from extreme or adverse weather.

This information sheet has four distinct parts:

- Reducing the risk
- Responding
- Responsibility of residents
- Contacts and information

This information sheet is available on request.

Reducing the risk:

- Maintain watercourses, dykes, ditches and culverts on your own property
- Report blockages in drainage ditches, dykes and culverts to the landowner or the Parish Council
- Report blocked drains and gullies to the Highways authority at Nottinghamshire County Council

Responding:

Once it has been determined by any resident that there is a likelihood of adverse weather, residents should implement their personal plan.

Likely indicators could be:

- General warnings issued by the Met Office
- Local weather conditions
- Local weather reports
- Monitoring the level of the River Soar over time
- Monitoring surface water and flow over time

Responsibility of residents:

- Read this weather resilience information sheet and encourage others to do the same
- Prepare a personal plan for extreme weather events
- Be familiar with the information sources and contact details provided in the plan
- Be aware of responsibilities for maintaining watercourses, dykes, ditches and culverts
- Ensure you have adequate insurance

NOTE: The Rushcliffe Borough Council will only deliver materials for protecting property during an extreme weather event to elderly and those considered vulnerable:
